Utility Buckets - "Slip on the forks" accessory buckets or Universal Fit buckets could be used along with whatever design or model of extendable reach lift truck. Regular universal lift truck buckets attach to blades that are up to 6" wide and are 48" long. Bigger fork pockets can be prearranged through an account executive upon request.

Because universal fit forklift buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the machine and are much less at risk to destruction. These buckets are also fifty percent deeper compared to the quick-tach bucket models. This extra space makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads like elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls and tearing off roof trash.

Quick-Tach Buckets

Quick-Tach Buckets are constructed for extendable-reach forklifts. They are made to allow placement of material way beyond the reach of a loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on the leading edge and on both sides reinforces stability, resistance to wear and offers supreme durability. Quick-Tach forklift buckets are enhanced by scuff bars along the bottom of the unit which shield it from scratches.

Quick-Tach lift truck buckets could be used to swap the carriage and forks that weigh between one hundred to seven hundred pounds. When installed, these buckets free up more of the unit's load capacity, enabling it to handle heavier and larger objects. The Quick-Tach can pour stuff about 1.5 feet higher thanks to the shorter depth of its bucket.
